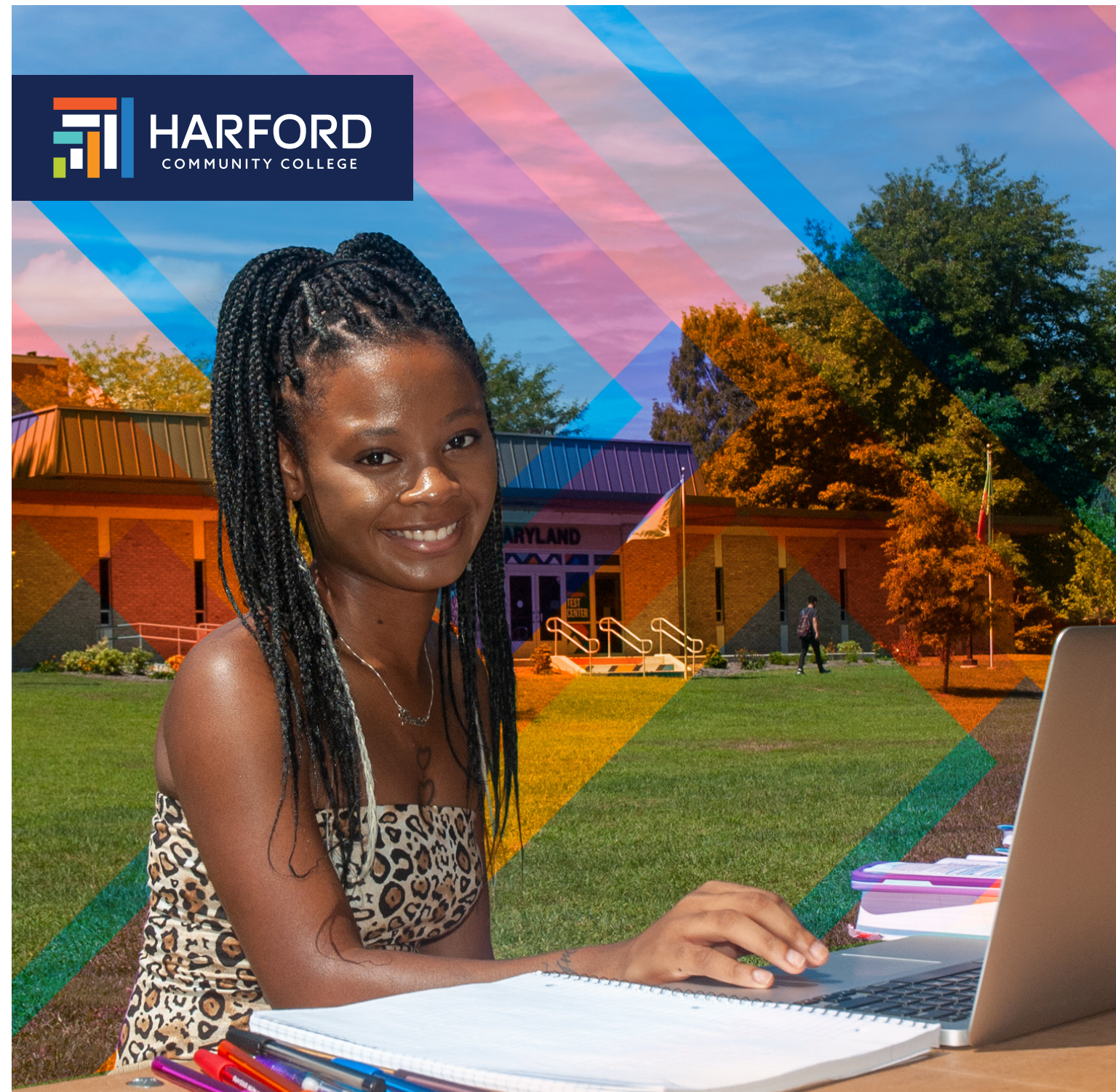

## TRANSCRIPT REQUIREMENTS

**New First-Time College Students:**

- You are applying for financial aid.
- You are still enrolled in high school, or you have graduated within the last three years.
- Your academic goal is an associate degree or certificate.

**New Transfer or College Graduate Students:**  
**Official college transcripts are required if any of the following apply to your application:**

- You are applying for Veteran's benefits.
- You are applying for financial aid.
- You want your previous college credits evaluated for transfer to HCC.
- You want to determine if you are exempt from the ACCUPLACER mathematics and/or English academic skills assessment requirements.

## NON-U.S. CITIZENS

Harford Community College grants admission to students regardless of citizenship. To receive the appropriate tuition rate, student will be contacted and asked to submit documentation electronically prior to the start of the semester verifying their immigration status. Students without valid immigration status will be charged the out-of-state tuition rate unless they are eligible for the MD Dream Act (SB 167).
