Eligibility: APPLICANTS MUST

- Be in good financial standing with the College
- Successfully complete required assessment tests prior to applying for grant
- Be at least 18 years' old
- Be a Maryland resident

This scholarship is awarded based on meeting the following criteria.

- 1. Student must be able to demonstrate that they are a graduate of Harford County Public Schools, or received their GED from Harford County.
- 2. Student receiving a 2.75 GPA or higher from a HCPS.
- 3. Must be Harford County resident.
- 4. Student must submit a scholarship narrative see pg. 3.
- 5. An Interview may be requested by the Harford Community College CET Scholarship Committee.

This scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 may be used for the following:

- Tuition
- Course Fees
- Textbooks
- Required program supplies or uniforms
- Used in combination with other awarded scholarships

This grant is funded by Harford Community College, and is not federally funded; FAFSA applications do not apply.

Continued funding for required courses in any program is contingent upon successful completion of each successive course and available funding.

- b) Are you receiving any other scholarship funds, and from who?

Qualified students may receive scholarship awards for one eligible workforce development program.
